About the Cover ~ On the evening of his resurrection Jesus appeared to his disciples while they sat behind locked doors, and he proved himself alive. Thomas, the Twin, was not there however. When the others told him they had seen the risen Christ, he was skeptical. But one week later Jesus appeared to them again and Thomas was with them. When Jesus offered the doubting disciple the opportunity to examine his wounds to know for sure it was really Jesus, Thomas exclaimed, "My Lord, and my God!" Of course, he was right. Jesus then spoke the famous words to him: "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed (John 20:29)." Here is a lesson for us. It is by faith that God wants us to grasp the blessings of all that Jesus accomplished for us by his perfect life and innocent death in our place -- faith that originates and is sustained only by his saving Word.
